The Union of Health and Environment Workers believes that everyone has the right to achieve his/her goals through education and hard work. With this in mind, UHEW offers five scholarships annually, each in the amount of \$3,000, to qualified dependents and/or members of the UHEW membership:

- Two scholarships are awarded on scholastic achievement named the Tony Tilley Scholastic Award and the Mary Stewart Scholastic Award;
- One scholarship is awarded to a candidate entering into an apprenticeship program;
- One scholarship is awarded to a member returning to school on a full-time basis to further his or her education; and
- One Human Rights scholarship.

The 2021 Scholarship will be awarded based on the merits of a maximum of a 500 word essay. Here is the topic for the essay:

- Provide your suggestions on how we can develop a youth engagement strategy working forward.
